CHARACTERISTICS OF SPECIALTY WALLCOVERING

Aleutian Natural Wallcovering is made from Sano, an aquatic, flowering plant native to the wetlands of southern Asia. To harvest, small boats are paddled into marshes and rice paddies, where it grows up to six feet tall and has roots that extend deep into the water. The long stalks are washed, trimmed, and laid out to dry for several days. Once dry, the bark is removed from the soft, woody stem to reveal its milky-white, spongy interior, which is cut into layers and transformed by skilled craftsmen into textiles and objects of art and utility.

Crafted entirely by hand from Sano, Aleutian's soft, suede-like texture reveals one-of-a-kind tonal variations and natural imperfections, which reinforce its unique beauty. See below for installation examples.
