

Changing the Cord Loop Troubleshooting Guide

Taking Off the Old Chain

- 1. Release the chain from the safety hold down.
- 2. Form a small loop in the chain and pass it through the gap between the guide and the cog.
- 3. Holding the loop like a handle, rotate the go, release the ball chain from the teeth of the cog as you go.
- 4. Once the chain is completely off the cog, slide it through the gap between the guide and the cog.



Putting On the New Chain

- 1. Slide a 4" loop of chain through the gap between the guide and the cog.
- 2. Using a pencil in an empty cob gap, rotate the cog clockwise feeding the chain into the teeth of the cog as you go.
- 3. Once the chain is completely in the cog, pull the excess chain back through the gap between the guide and the cog.
- 4. Reattach the safety tie-down.
