## Multiple Shades on One Headrail <br> Measuring Guide

## Instructions

1. For inside mounts, measure the overall width of the window in three (3) different places. Use the narrowest dimensions
2. On outside mounts, add a minimum of $3^{\prime \prime}$ for overlap
3. Measure from the far left side of the window to the place where the first window panel ends (left shade), then from the place where the first window panel ends to the place where the second window panel ends (center shade) and then from the place where the second panel ends to the far right side of the window (right shade)
4. LENGTH: Measure the EXACT length of the window in two (2) places. Use the shortest dimension
5. Submit a diagram with your order showing any obstacles or special instructions

## NOTE:

A deduction will be made between each panel for operational clearance and valance may or may not be continuous.
